Room - to - Room Trading all day and all night from Wednesday, February 17th until Sunday, February 20th! Don't miss out on that one 'item' you have to have!

Please remember to wear your Badge at all times as this is a private party and people that do not have their Badge on will be asked to leave. This has to do with the State Liquor Law and remember, you are responsible for your own behavior and that of your guests.

The Hospitality Room is open 24 hours a day, beginning on Wednesday at 12:00 noon and ending at noon on Sunday.

TRADE FLOOR TABLES

On Thursday around 10 or 11 a.m., as soon as the tables arrive, we will be setting them up. This is staffed by the Richbrau and Rusty Bunch Chapters but ALL are invited to help. Please do NOT just take a table to set it up for yourself. These tables will be available on Thursday and Friday so that the collectors in the other Hotels can participate in the room-to-room The tables are ONLY for collectors not staying in the Ramada Inn and those in the back building, (all odd numbered rooms from 301-341 and from 401-441). Collectors in the main building and on the front side of the back building will have their room open for the room-to-room trading. So check out all of the outside rooms! On Saturday, the tables are open to ALL collectors EXCEPT those who have inside rooms (open to the Atrium of the Ramada).

THE BREWERY TOUR IS BACK!

This year's tour is scheduled For Thursday, February 17th. The bus will depart the hotel at 9:15 a.m. and is scheduled to return by 5:30 p.m., dependent on the notorious I-95 traffic congestion. If you want to join the tour and do not have an advance ticket, there are probably still seats available. The cost is \$25.

Check with the Blue Gray registration table Wednesday or just look for Jim Plant at 9 a.m. on Thursday morning in the hotel lobby. The bus is headed to *Port City Brewing* in Alexandria first. It is a production brewery with a tasting room that just opened on Feb 1st. Lunch will be at the second stop, *Mad Fox Brewing* in Falls Church. Blue Gray veterans may be familiar with local celebrity brewer, Bill Madden, owner and brewer at *Mad Fox*. After leaving Mad Fox we'll head to *Vintage 50 Brewery* in Leesburg.

Speaking of great beers, *the Blue & Gray Brewery* is located just 9 minutes from the hotel (4.83 miles away). They offer free tastings and retail sales on Wednesdays from 2 pm-6 pm, Fridays from 3 pm-8 pm and Saturdays from 10 am – 1 pm. While you are there, you can purchase growlers and/or get them refilled! Tours are available on Saturdays from 10 am – 1 pm. They now have "Lee's Retreat Brew Pub" onsite that is open for lunch and dinner. It is open Tuesday through Thursday 11 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., and Friday and Saturday from 11:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. Get a coupon at the Registration Desk for one free pint glass with a beer purchase at the Brewery!

BACK BAR DISPLAY

The Back Bar Display is back again with another diverse round of rare, premium quality, and lighted breweriana of Pre-pro to early 1950s vintage. As always, there will be a Best of Show Contest with prizes and awards for the winners – please remember to stop by the display and cast your vote. When visiting and viewing the display, there are front-row seats where you can sit, relax and listen to many memorable tunes from the 1930s and 1940s 'Big Band' era while you enjoy a cold draft beer from The Blue & Gray hospitality room. The Back Bar lounge will also be up and running so you can enjoy your beer and meet the display organizer (John Bain) and other participants. In addition, there will be numerous 1930s to 1950s lighted signs for sale in the lounge. Please note that the voting deadline has been moved to Friday evening as well as the photo op and award ceremony.

A Special this week is that the Ale House will have on tap, Schafly Beer, a different beer every

night!

HUNGRY?

Check out the Garden Terrace Restaurant at the Ramada Inn to see what they have available while we are there. In addition, there is a **great** Breakfast available at the **Waffle House** a short distance from the hotel.

There will be a **Hotdog Stand** available on Thursday, Friday and Saturday from noon to 3:00 p.m., near the Back Bar displays..

Hooters Restaurant, the Pancho Villas Mexican Restaurant and Ruby Tuesdays are just a short walking distance away.

The Blue Gray Brewery is only 4.83 miles (9 minutes) away where you can enjoy great lunches and dinners at Lee's Retreat Brew Pub, including kid's meals. Stop at the registration desk to get a coupon for "A free pint glass with any beer purchase" at the Brewery.

SATURDAY IS IMPORTANT

Rayner thought it was important to remind everyone that the reason we get such good rates for the hotel is because we promise them so many booked rooms every night. Therefore, it is imperative that you stay over Saturday night. If we can't deliver on Saturday nights, we may lose the rights to having just our people at the hotel.
